

Fukushima Film and Media Festival 2014 -Call for Entries (Film Category)

The Fukushima Film and Media Festival, now in its second year, curate films and TV programs related to Fukushima after the disaster and aims to project the reality of present-day Fukushima through a diverse range of perspectives. Our approach is to share stories and provide insights from all over the world to help people deepen their understanding about life after this terrible tragedy.

We are currently accepting submissions for the film category. Selected films will be screened at the festival in September 2014.

- ◆ Name Fukushima Film and Media Festival 2014
- ◆ Dates Fukushima Film and Media Festival 2014 will be held in Tokyo, Japan for one week in September 2014. *Specific Dates will be announced later.
- ◆ Organization Fukushima Film and Media Festival 2014 is organized by Our Planet TV (NPO) and Pole Pole Higashi-Nakano (Theater).

Entry Submission

Entry Fee Free

Eligibility

- Any work related to events in Fukushima after the tsunami, earthquake, and nuclear accident will be considered
- All work must be produced after 2012
- All work must be in Japanese or captioned with Japanese subtitles
- All work must be between 30min and 120min in length.
- Any and all genres are welcome. (Documentary, fiction films, animation and shorts are acceptable)
- Screening material has to be provided in the form of DVD, Blu-ray, HDV, DVCAM or 35mm film.

Entry Deadline 31 May *

***All entries must ARRIVE (not be postmarked) by 31 May.**

Shipping Expense The entrant is responsible for the cost of shipping DVDs and accompanying materials.

Entrants are required to submit the following material

1. DVD or DVD-R (NTSC only) *Submitted DVDs will not be returned.
2. Press kit (Please include contact information, synopsis and staff profile. English or Japanese are acceptable.)

Selection Process

The festival organizers (Our Planet TV and Pole Pole Higashi-Nakano) will deliberate and select the work to be screened. Entrants will be officially noticed by 30 June.

Selected films

Selected films will be screened at Fukushima Film and Media Festival 2014. A Screening Fee will be paid. (Details of fee not yet determined)
